The Board of Commissioners of the Port of Astoria ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE

This ordinance shall be entitled and shall be known as the "Ordinance Restricting Parking".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to protect and provide safe Port facilities.

SECTION 3. CONFORMANCE OF STATE LAW

This ordinance shall not substitute for nor eliminate the necessity for conformity with any and all laws or rules of the State of Oregon, or its agencies, or any ordinance, rule, or regulation of the Port of Astoria.

SECTION 4. INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS

This ordinance shall supersede, control and repeal any inconsistent provision of any Port of Astoria ordinance as amended or any other regulations made by the Port of Astoria.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. AUTHORITY

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to ORS 777.190 and ORS 198.510 et seq.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect on the 30th day following adoption by the Board of Port Commissioners as provided in ORS 198.570.

SECTION 8. ADOPTION CLAUSE

The Board of Commissioners of the Port of Astoria hereby adopts the restrictions on parking set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

EXHIBIT A

1. Designation of Zones. The Executive Director is authorized to designate zones for general parking, restrictive parking, and no parking on all Port properties. In addition, the Executive Director is authorized to designate those areas under Port control that are high security areas. Signs shall be posted to designate the parking zones and high security areas.

Except for temporary purposes when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with directives of a peace officer or Port security officer, it shall be unlawful for anyone to:

- a. Park in a no parking zone;
- b. Park in a restrictive parking zone without a permit properly displayed.

2. Restrictive Parking Permits. Permits for parking in restrictive parking zones shall be issued by the Executive Director (or designee). Persons wishing to park in a restricted zone will provide Port with their name, address, purpose for parking and identification of the vehicle or vehicles they are driving, and any required fees. The Commission may by resolution establish permit fees. Port shall provide permit holders with a parking permit. A permit holder shall display and hang the permit from the rear view mirror of the vehicle.

3. Penalties. Any peace officer is authorized to cite violators for violation of this ordinance using the Uniform Traffic Citation according to ORS 153.045. Violation of this ordinance is a Class D violation under the provisions of ORS 153.012.

4. Removal. Any vehicle parked in a no parking zone or parked in a restricted parking zone without a permit, may be removed pursuant to ORS 819.110 to 819.200. Any vehicle parked illegally within that portion of Port property designated as a high security area, is hereby declared a hazard and obstruction and may be immediately removed pursuant to ORS 819.120. The Executive Director is authorized to either personally conduct, or designate a hearings officer to conduct, any hearing required under ORS 819.190.
