ORDINANCE NO. 82-01

An ordinance to provide for the control of dogs and disposal of refuse at the PORT OF ASTORIA MARINAS.

ARTICLE I

Responsibility of the Dogowners at Port of Astoria

Marinas:

1.01 In the interest of health and safety all dogs shall be leashed and under control of owners at all times while on ramps, floats and walkways at the Port of Astoria Marinas.

1.02 The owners of dogs, while on Port property, shall immediately remove any animal waste caused to be placed upon the Port property by their dogs.

ARTICLE II

2.01 All users of the Port of Astoria Marina shall be responsible for disposing of all their refuse and receptacles provided at the marina terminal. No refuse shall be placed on the docks, piers, walkways or ramps, excepting in containers provided for that purpose.

ARTICLE III

3.01 Marina tenants found in violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to:

(a) Loss of marina privileges;

(b) Damages in an amount equal to the actual cost to the Port of Astoria to remedy the situation created by the violation of this ordinance by the tenant, together with reasonable attorney's fees for any action brought to enforce any provision of this ordinance.

(c) A fine of not more than \$250 or imprisonment of not more than 30 days, or both.

(d) Either one or all of the above remedies.

ARTICLE IV

4.01 It is the duty of the Port Marina Manager and the Chief Port Watchman, through their staff, to enforce all the above provisions of this ordinance.

4.02 Any peace officer may enforce this ordinance.
